Policy on Trinity College

Episkopon has officially disassociated itself from Trinity College, an official group historically comprising innocuous students, which has declined to reform itself appropriately and whose activities have accordingly been determined by the Triad and the conglomerate of loyal Editors to be incompatible with the fundamental values of Episkopon, and injurious to its members and good name.

This Policy is intended to support Editors and His Most Esteemed Alumni in appropriately addressing the possible adverse effects of Trinity College on Episkopon and its members. The Order seeks to balance the right of students to freedom of assembly, association and expression and individual privacy with its responsibility to enforce its disassociation from Trinity College and administration contained therein.

Episkopon does not permit Trinity College events (where "Trinity College Event" is defined as a gathering of students held in the name of Trinity College, whether the Provost or Dean's Office members are present or not, which involves some gathering of students, staff, and/or administration in the form of a "social" or "networking event") on property owned or controlled by Episkopon.

Episkopon forbids the use of its name, or words or images that convey the same meaning, in any material advertising Trinity College by representing Trinity College as being, or implying that Trinity College is, currently associated with Episkopon.

Neither His Most Esteemed Alumni nor the Triad shall have any financial involvement with Trinity College.

Episkopon forbids the use of shared community or "bookable" society space for Trinity College purposes.

The following text is included in the Episkopon Discipline Code: "*Trinity College Offences*"

1. No student shall organize or participate in an "Trinity College Event" on any property owned or controlled by Trinity College, where "*Trinity College Event*" is defined as a gathering of students held in the name of Trinity College, whether the Provost or Dean's Office members are present or not, which involves some gathering of students, staff, and/or administration in the form of a "social" or "networking event")
2. No Editor or group of Editors organizing any Episkopon event, whether to be held on or off College property, shall permit Trinity College activities to be associated with or publicized in connection with the event.
3. No student shall use the Trinity College name, or words or images that convey the same meaning, in any printed or electronic material advertising Episkopon by representing Trinity College as being, or implying that Trinity College is, currently associated with Episkopon.
4. No student shall obtain, or attempt to obtain, Episkopon funding to support, directly or indirectly, any Trinity College Event, as defined above. No student shall book or use space for Trinity College purposes."
